

System Requirements

- Laptop computer with an available PC Card slot
- Cardbus controller properly installed and working
- An 802.11b Access Point for **Infrastructure mode** or another 802.11b wireless adapter for **Ad-Hoc mode**.



Installing the Drivers




- **Turn ON** the laptop computer.
- Insert the DWL-650
 Wireless PC Adapter into
 an available PC Card slot in
 the laptop.
- The "New Hardware Wizard" screen will appear.
- Select "Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)"
- Click Next


NOTE: If this screen does not appear, go to **Start > Control Panel > Switch to Classic View > Add Hardware**. Double-click on the icon.



Installing the Drivers (continued)



- Select "Search for the best drivers in these locations."
- Browse for the drivers on the driver CD i.e. D:\XP where D: refers to the CD-ROM drive
- Click Next




• Click on Continue Anyway.

• Windows will load the necessary files.

• Click **Finish** to complete the installation.



Connecting to the Wireless Network



• Right-Click on the wireless icon in the taskbar



- Select "View Available Wireless Networks"
- **NOTE**: If unable to view the wireless networks, please re-insert the wireless PC card.

2 Connecting to the Wireless Network




• Select the wireless network. In this case, **default** is selected.



• Click Connect

- The taskbar will display the status of the wireless network.
- Double-click on the icon.



• The status of the wireless connection will be displayed.
